


CWTS Effectiveness Statement 2025


The faculty of Christian Witness Theological Seminary is committed to designing effective programs and their ongoing evaluation in accordance with the mission of the School.

I. Admissions Rate (2018-2025)




II. Graduation Rates (2017-2025)




| Programs | Graduation Rates (2017-2025) averaged |
|------------------------------------|---------------------------------------|
| Master of Christian Ministry (MCM) | 39% |
| Master of Biblical Studies (MBS) | 42% |
| Master of Divinity (MDiv) | 78% |
| Master of Theology (ThM) | 92% |
| Doctor of Ministry (DMin) | 36% |

Note: These show the graduation rates within twice the expected duration of the programs. The actual graduation rates were much higher than these; that is, most students took longer than expected to graduate, but graduated eventually.


III. Graduate Overall Satisfaction by Degree Program





2013-25 MBS satisfaction on overall experience in CWTS (%)
